Notwithstanding having agreed to receive your further comments by 11 October, we do not seem to have received a written response to our letter of 2 September concerning this complaint. If you have not already replied, would you please do so in order to allow this matter to proceed.

I must again draw your attention to Paragraph 905(d) of the Code of Conduct which states that it is the duty of a barrister to respond promptly to any request for comments or information on a complaint.

If we do not receive a reply within two weeks of the date of this letter, we will have no option but to put the matter before the Complaints Commissioner without your comments. It is open to him to refer the matter to the Professional Conduct and Complaints Committee for consideration forthwith.

It would be most helpful if you would quote the reference given above in any communication about this matter.
