Re: Mr S H Gallagher

3rd June 05 letter from BC states "Today forwarding your file to LSO"

(A)

We have now received the file in the case shown above from the General Council of the Bar (Bar Council). After a preliminary consideration of your file, the Ombudsman has decided to investigate the way in which the Bar Council dealt with your complaint. One of the Ombudsman's investigating officers will do this.

Proving the collusion between the two: LSO's 08.04.05 letter that it had asked for the file

What if the Ombudsman finds in my favour?

- If the Ombudsman decides that the Bar Council didn't investigate your complaint properly, she may recommend that they reconsider some or all of your complaint.
- If the Ombudsman decides that the Bar Council caused you unnecessary inconvenience, distress, or loss, she may decide that the Bar Council should pay you compensation. (Last year the average compensation award was £431.)

We deal with complaints in date order. Unfortunately, I cannot give you a precise estimate of how long it will take before we can look into your case. We normally expect to prepare the Ombudsman's report within six months at most. You can obtain further information about the Ombudsman's office at www.olso.org
