I have developed the following personal website <http://www.leasehold-outrage.com> because, as stated on the site "there is no avenue open to me for justice and redress in England".

The home page to the site provides a comprehensive overview of my case.

The site is supported by 800 evidential documents to which a hyperlink is provided whenever referred to. A reference library of a substantial part of these documents is contained under http://www.leasehold-outrage.com/pg_other/document_library.php - which is a list of the 25 battles I have had to engage since 2002 in an attempt to get justice and redress.

The site took me 17 months to develop using over 2,000 hours of my life. (I initially developed the content in Word: a total of 600 pages)

It was launched last week. It is on a US ISP server, called Verio. Verio sent me the attached email last night which is a request from one of the landlord's solicitors to close it down claiming, among other that I am making false accusations.

- at the 13 Feb 07 meeting with Peter Bassett, partner, and Jeanette Dunworth, HR: Header 3 of [my 17.01.08 Grievance](#) to KPMG;

Following my filing a [03.04.08 Claim](#) against KPMG in [the Employment Tribunal](#), under **para.7** of its [PACK OF LIES Defence](#) (includes my Comments), KPMG claimed that I had committed

"a serious breach of the IT policy which could potentially have led to [my] dismissal".

Aside from the fact that KPMG mixed DELIBERATELY the 13 Feb 07 meeting (**sections 3.1 to 3.3 [KPMG page](#)**) with the 30 Mar 07 meeting (**section 3.4**)...

...as discussed under **section 3.2 [KPMG page](#)** and, e.g., in my **05.08.08** letter to [ACAS](#), **lines 189 - 230**, I hold the view that **this is NOT true**).
