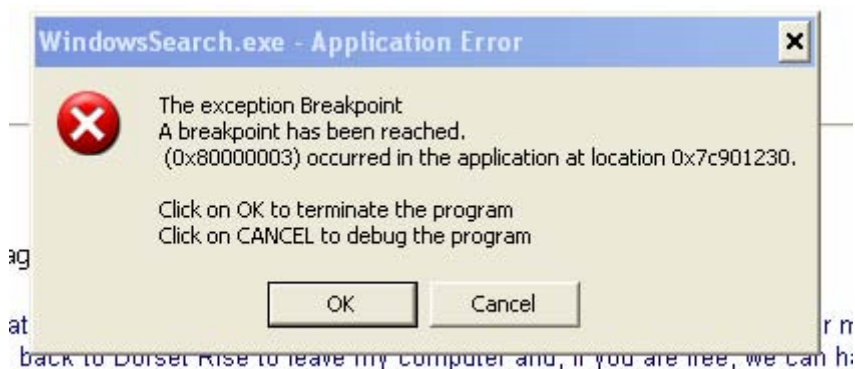

I took a printscreen of this message appearing on the computer I was using at my then employer, [KPMG](#), on **3 Oct 07** – at **08h40**.



As I recall, **it had happened previously**.

I am not an IT expert, and **do not know what the actual cause was**.

Under e.g. **Header 9.1** of my [17.01.08](#) Grievance, I reported that

"since end Apr / early May 07, every 2-3 minutes, and sometimes even more frequently, everything 'jumps' on my computer: the icons, files and shortcuts on my desktop".

That I had checked with **an IT expert** who had **agreed me that everything I typed was being captured**, and he had **suggested that the software used might be Demon**.
