

26 Oct 07 - PRINTSCREEN – Access to Websense denied (captured by Noëlle Klosterkötter-Dit-Rawé – www.leasehold-outrage.com)



The above printscreen is the outcome of my **attempting to access a site for, as I recall, a conference call**. The same thing happened on **21.11.07**.

WHY?

To his **24.04.07-09h10** email, **Peter Bassett, partner**, attached a 23 Apr 07 letter 'from' **Jeanette Dunworth, HR (= Bassett)** for me to sign – 'agreeing' to be barred from accessing the internet. **By then, I had been UNLAWFULLY cut-off from ALL internal and external sites for 24 DAYS.** (sections 3.4 and 4 **KPMG page**).

I complied with the order by attaching my signed letter to my **25.04.07-13h45** email to Bassett and my line manager, **Ceri Hughes**.

As can be seen from the letter, **the ONLY external site I was "allowed to access" was "Webex" – "so that [I] could take part in internal conference calls"**.

As I reported under e.g. **Header 4.7** of my **17.01.08** Grievance (section 11 **KPMG pg**), **by Nov 07 KPMG HAD ALSO CUT OFF my access to the WEBEX.COM site.**

Of note: During 'part 1' of my so-called 'performance appraisal' with **Hughes** on **09.10.07** (I secretly recorded; recording under **section 8.1 KPMG pg**) – at **lines 548-553, Hughes had emphasised that "it [was] important [for me] to be [on these calls]"** (section 8.3(3) **KPMG pg**).

The above emails contain my Comments.
