### **SUBJECT ACCESS REQUEST – DATA PROTECTION ACT 1998**

Further to [your undated ET3](#) reply to [my 3 April 2008 claim](#), posted to me by the Tribunal on 17 June 2008, can you please forward this request to the relevant Data Controller.

6. **Of:** *“In January 2007 Mr Ladsky made further contact with the Respondent and threatened legal action against the Respondent in connection with allegations of libel”.*
7. Likewise, the 5 October 2007 eventual response to my 9 July 2007 Subject Access Request did not contain any document relating to this. In fact, this is new information to me.
8. Please provide copy of Mr Ladsky’s correspondence, including any electronic transmission, record of any meetings and of any telephone conversations relating to the “*allegations*” - and any evidence he provided in support of his “*allegations*”.
9. **Under “[IT Restrictions](#)”, paragraph 6:**
10. **Of:** *“The Respondent...obtained an IT report relating to the Claimant’s IT use. Following receipt of the IT report (which highlighted some 10,000 hits on a small number of websites related to the Claimant’s “personal issues”)...”*
11. Please provide a copy of the IT report.

12. Please supply copy of briefing / introduction notes, any notes of meetings, telephone conversations ahead of my consultation with the therapist, Shirley Caplin, 46 Harley Street, London, on 10 April 2007 (at KPMG's insistence).
13. Please supply copy of the report issued by Shirley Caplin following my consultation with her on 10 April 2007 – and all documents, including email traffic, any notes of meetings, telephone conversations mentioning me or relating to my circumstances following this consultation.
14. Please supply detail of Shirley Caplin's qualifications.
15. Please supply copy of all documents, including email traffic, any notes of meetings, telephone conversations mentioning me or relating to my circumstances in the context of my contact with Julie Bennett, Well Being (at KPMG's insistence). (NB: I do have a copy of the emails sent to me by Julie Bennett).
16. Please supply copy of all documents, including email traffic, any notes of meetings, telephone conversations mentioning me or relating to my circumstances in the context of the telephone contact initiated by Seraphina Burch, Occupational Health Adviser, Bupa Wellness, on [8 May 2007](#).
17. Please supply any other documents contained on my file relating to my personal circumstances – not covered by the above and in my attached [1 July 2008](#)<sup>1</sup> Request for Additional Information.

While Part I, 7(8) and (10) of the Data Protection Act 1998 sets a forty-day deadline for reply, given the circumstances, I would appreciate a reply from you within the next 14 days of receipt of this request i.e. at the latest by Wednesday 16 July 2008 (Part I – 1.7(11) of DPA 1998).
