We write with reference to your letter of 15th January enclosing a copy of the letter received from Miss Dit-Rawe asking for a delay in the Hearing in respect of the above case. We would inform you that our clients object to the delay.

Miss Dit-Rawe was informed of the Tribunal's Directions back in October 2003 which set out the timetable to deal with the various matters. She was also at the Hearing and did not object to the timetable then. The deadline for the residents to submit their Experts' reports was 7th January 2003 but this letter was not sent until 12th January 2003.

The documents that Miss Dit-Rawe has requested have been available in the Porter's room since the original notice was served and she in fact has inspected them. She has been offered her own copies of the schedule of condition and the specification on the same basis as the other lessees, some of which took up the option, i.e. on payment of photocopy charges. We also arranged a meeting of the lessees in November to discuss the disputed items and Miss Dit-Rawe declined to attend. At that meeting various points were discussed and those lessees who wanted a copy of the detailed breakdown of the estimate from Killby and Gayford bought one at that meeting.
