Dear Yemah

I am writing to make you aware of some of the happenings at Jefferson house today.

Between 11 and 11.30am my wife was alone in our flat when she heard someone using a key to try and enter our flat. She called out my name twice and on getting no reply she opened the door to see who was outside. On opening the door she saw a Mr. Ladsky talking to a lady in front of our door. On seeing my wife he said goodbye to the lady and quickly walked up the stairs.

I had changed my lock a while ago and whoever was trying to enter obviously had the old key.

The police were called and he spoke to Mr. Ladsky who admitted that he had tried to enter our flat for the purposes of getting our windows cleaned.

It concerns me greatly that someone should, thinking they have a key to my flat, try and enter. I was made aware by the police man that Mr. Ladsky owns 6 flats within the block but surely this does not give him any right to enter my flat.

I would also like to make you aware of the following:

- The flat below mine has been vacant for some time and the present owners have left various things including a toilet, bathtub and fridge as well as general rubbish lying in the basement directly below the windows of my flat. This looks bad and people passing add to the rubbish.
- Pigeon netting previously fixed outside our bathroom window was removed when building works were carried out to one of the flats above. It was damaged and since February the netting has been left useless and hanging. We complained many times to the porter but nothing has been done.
