Dear Madam / Sir

Your assistance in getting the skeleton argument from Portner and Jaskel

I wish to bring to your attention the fact that Portner and Jaskel has so far failed to supply me with its skeleton argument, and by the same token, evidence in support of its client's claim against me. By contrast, it received my skeleton argument on 4 May 2007 i.e. more than three months ago.

Attached is my second request to Portner and Jaskel, dated 12 August 2007¹. It received my previous request, dated 30 June 2007, on 4 July 2007 (attached²). In its communication of 12 July 2007 (attached³) it totally ignored my request. I expected that it would subsequently send me its skeleton argument. It has not.

The hearing is scheduled for 24 August 2007. Clearly, non-provision of the skeleton argument puts me in a highly unfair and very disadvantageous position in relation to the hearing.

Hence, Portner and Jaskel is in breach of its legal obligations under Section 1.3 of the CPR, "Duty of the parties: The parties are required to help the court to further the overriding objective"

In light of its wholly unreasonable unwillingness to supply me with the requested information, I seek your assistance in requesting from Portner and Jaskel that it sends me a copy of its skeleton argument – ensuring that it is delivered to me **by Thursday 16 August 2007**. (I have communicated this date in my attached letter of 12 August 2007 to Portner and Jaskel).

In my skeleton argument I have, very amply I believe, demonstrated that Portner and Jaskel's client claim against me is dishonest and vexatious. Its highly unreasonable conduct adds weight to my position.

I have warned Portner and Jaskel, now for the second time, that I will seek my costs on an indemnity basis. I have also informed it that, at the appropriate time, I intend to request a Wasted Costs Order, as well as an Extended Civil Restraint Order.

Amended 3 April 2007 Order Should be 'notice'

I also take this opportunity to remind you that on 3 July 2007 I sent your Court a letter dated 30 June 2007 (attached⁴) requesting that you supply me with an amended version of your 3 April 2007 Order as the information captured is incorrect. To date I have not received a reply. I consequently reiterate my request that you please send me an amended version.

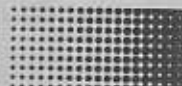
