I acknowledge receipt of your 'General Form of Judgment or Order' dated 1 July 2004 to which was attached the 'Draft Consent Order' sent to you by CKFT. **The Consent Order does not have the stamp of the Court on it.** I do not know whether there should be one to endorse its validity
